COURSE DESCRIPTION

History course focusing on the World's Story of Liberty and Principles of Freedom. Classes will be held in-person on Fridays from 9 to 11 am in Draper, Utah. The cost is \$300 per student for the 30 week, year-long course. Classes begin on September 8, 2023 and end on May 24, 2024. This class is for students ages 11-15 and has a capacity of 25 students.

COURSE DETAILS

This course details the amazing yet challenging journey that liberty has made through the ages. It will provide a glimpse into the hearts and minds of the many men and women who gave life itself to preserve the light of liberty. Within this context, students will be taught the most important principles of freedom for happy and prosperous civilizations.
